Final determination of eligibility for this waiver will require that you complete the 2009/10 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as an independent student and that you identify yourself as a Dislocated Worker on that document. According to federal regulations, a person who meets one of the following conditions is considered a dislocated worker:

- Has been laid off or received a lay-off notice.
- Is receiving unemployment benefits due to being laid off or losing a job and is unlikely to return to a previous occupation.
- Is self-employed and is now unemployed due to economic conditions.

A person who quits work is generally not considered a dislocated worker even if, for example, the person is receiving unemployment benefits. The Office of Student Financial Aid may require that you submit documentation confirming your status as a Dislocated Worker.

Missouri State University offers this unique scholarship to individuals who have been dislocated from the workforce. It is intended to help these Missouri residents prepare for their future through completion of a Missouri State degree.

The RENEW scholarship will be awarded to students who are Missouri residents and who meet the following criteria.

The student must

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as an independent student and meet the criteria to file as a Dislocated Worker on that form.
- Show a financial need as determined by the results of the FAFSA.
- Be registered for a minimum of six credit hours as a degree-seeking undergraduate student or five credit hours as a teacher certification or degree-seeking graduate student.
- Not be the recipient of any type of full tuition reimbursement from any source other than federal and state aid which is awarded based on FAFSA results.

This scholarship does not apply to current students at Missouri State University. The award of \$750 per semester for part-time students (six-11 credit hours for undergraduates, five-eight credit hours for graduates) and \$1350 per semester for full-time students (12 or more credit hours for undergraduates, nine or more credit hours for graduates) will be applied to the student's account upon receipt of required documentation and verification of application criteria. University application and registration deadlines apply. The RENEW scholarship is available for the fall and spring semesters. This scholarship is renewable each semester through the spring 2011 semester for students who maintain satisfactory academic progress. To renew for the 2010-11 academic year, students must complete a new FAFSA and meet the need criteria as listed above for the appropriate academic year.
